Fire in the Park

At 12:45AM on September 7th at space #16 a tragic fire took the life of Sandy Strong, a 15 year resident. She is survived by a son who lives out of the area. Roland Pacey in #18 noticed the fire soon after it started. He alerted the neighbors & used a water hose to knock the fire back until the fire department arrived. **We are all in debt to Roland for his brave action.** Karren in #6 kept the hose on the fire while Roland went inside to look for Sandy. We appreciate everything that Roland, Karren & other neighbors did to help.

We learned a few things from this fire that we'd like to share with the community.

Insurance: It is important to review our coverage limits on our homeowner insurance policies annually. Without "Replacement" coverage, most of us would be left without a home in the event of a total loss. The current rental agreement requires "replacement" homeowner insurance.

Sirens: A resident questioned why sirens were not used in the park. The Fire dept. explained that the purpose of sirens is to clear traffic for the fire trucks. Once the trucks enter the park, traffic is no longer a problem. The Fire dept. also is on the radio ordering more trucks or receiving information from dispatch and it is difficult to communicate with the sirens on. The fire dept. would go door to door to notify residents if the situation required evacuation.
