COMMUNITY CARE RESPONSE UNIT

Fire District 3

The Community Care Response Unit (CCRU) is committed to assisting the patrons of Central Point, Gold Hill, White City, Sam's Valley, Eagle Point, and Agate Lake to provide alternative solutions to meet their medical needs. We assist family members to understand their medical situation and care plan for their loved ones while helping the patients navigate post physician care and thriving in their homes.

We are working to implement an advanced triage process at the 911 dispatch center, this will allow a more appropriate resource, such as the CCRU, a small SUV with an EMT and Paramedic, to handle the situation. This allows district personnel to spend more time with the patron to determine a short and long-term solution to their need.

Additionally, the CCRU can help Fire District patrons navigate the complex health care system. Instead of having the patient go to the hospital emergency room in an ambulance, an alternative destination or treatment plan may be available. Telehealth, Urgent Care or Physician Clinics can be more viable options. The community care team works with our patrons to determine the best possible outcome for their needs. This requires team members to utilize a mix of skills in emergency medicine, social work, problem-solving, and keen working knowledge of the available community and health services.

Power Outage Tips

Conserve water. The park has a limited amount of water in a storage tank. This water comes to our homes by gravity. However, once we empty the tank electricity is required to refill the tank.

To conserve body heat, everyone should wear layers of clothing and a hat, and use blankets to keep warm. Moving around and staying active will also help to warm you up.

Carbon Monoxide and Power Outages

If you lose power during the colder months, you may be tempted to use an unsafe heating source in your house. This should never be done as it is not only a fire hazard but can cause carbon monoxide poisoning which can be fatal.

Use flash lights in the dark, not candles.

Keep refrigerator and freezer

doors closed as much as possible. An unopened refrigerator will keep foods cold for about 4 hours. A full freezer will keep the temperature for about 48 hours (24 hours if it is half full) if the door remains closed.
