# Call-A-Ride Program

This is a volunteer program. Volunteers use their own vehicles to drive seniors to and from medical appointments.

## Volunteers Needed

Here is some information about the volunteer opportunity and I would encourage anyone who is interested to give me a call. I am the coordinator the Call-A-Ride program and I meet with all our volunteers in our office before they begin volunteering.

\*Volunteers must be over the age of 55, have an Oregon Driver's License, and current auto insurance

\*Volunteers use their own vehicles to drive seniors in Jackson County to and from medical appointments

\*Our organization offers mileage reimbursement at .30/mile to drivers, we provide volunteer liability insurance at no cost to the driver, and we have wonderful recognition events throughout the year to honor our volunteers

\*We perform Oregon DMV Check and an Oregon Criminal History Check on all

our volunteers before they can drive any clients

\*The need in our community for medical transportation is HUGE. We currently have 45 volunteers and 175 clients, but we have over 100 people on our waitlist hoping to use our services when we recruit more volunteers.

\*Volunteers have no set schedule, no minimum or maximum amount of volunteer hours, and can decide each week what they would like to help with. Drivers received a call or an email each week to see if and what they can be helpful for in the following week.
